

PONY LEAGUE FALL BASEBALL!

Autumn is the very best time to play baseball in the Chicago area. The weather from Labor Day to Halloween is usually ideal, with sunny and cool afternoons. After the summer heat, the winds coming off Lake Michigan are now warm.

And our players have had the regular season (and some have had the summer season) to hone their baseball skills to a fine edge.

From its start six years ago with just three Skokie Indians teams, our Pony League Fall Ball program has grown to include teams from Skokie Indians, Morton Grove, Glenview, Evanston, Edgebrook-Sauganash and Portage Park in Chicago, and Kenilworth-Winnetka. In fact, Fall Ball has grown so large that the North Suburban Youth Baseball Association (NSYBA) will run the program this year, as it did our pony league regular season.

A GREAT SCHEDULE

The season runs from the first Saturday after Labor Day to around Halloween.

Nearly all our games will be on Saturdays, with a possible optional game on a weeknight under the lights at area parks.

We recognize that Skokie Indians players also play fall sports so please tell us on the registration form what days you're available to play. We'll do our best to accommodate other fall sports schedules.

WHERE WE'LL PLAY

Our home games will be at Central Park and Laramie. Away games will be at Prairie View in Morton Grove, Wildwood in Chicago, Huber Park in Glenview, or James Park in Evanston.

WHO CAN PLAY

Baseball players of league ages 12 through 14. Your league age is how old you are on August 1, 2004. Fall Ball is really important for our graduating Little League players: it gives you the opportunity to learn baseball under professional baseball
