You're receiving this because you were identified as a possible Community Representative to the NSYBA for the 2010 Spring season. If we are in error or need to add additional contacts, please let us know.

We are planning to have the following leagues participating this year: Skokie Indians, Skokie Youth, Golf-Maine, Morton Grove, Lincolnwood, and Evanston, plus other area leagues. We still have time to add other communities and teams to the program. Please advise as early as possible.

The 2010 Spring season will start on Saturday, April 24, and end before Saturday, July 3. If your team would like to play exhibition games on the weekend of April 17, please let us know before Friday, April 6.

Before Monday, April 5, 2010, we will need from each community and/or team sponsored by each community your decision as to whether to participate in the 2010 NSYBA Spring season. Before Monday, April 12, we need the following administrative requirements and paperwork:

- a. A roster for each team (use the roster form on [www.nsyba.org](http://www.nsyba.org)).
- b. Copies of birth certificates for each rostered player.
- c. A waiver/release form signed by each player and his/her parent and/or guardian. Please use the form provided on [www.nsyba.org](http://www.nsyba.org).
- d. A certificate of insurance identifying the sponsoring community and/or its youth baseball association, the insurer and the insurance producer with "North Suburban Youth Baseball Association" shown as an additional insured.
- e. Availability dates and times for your home diamond(s), along with the rainout hotline for your park district.
- f. \$75.00 per team entry fee, with the check or money order payable to "NSYBA."

Attached please find a copy of our TENTATIVE 2010 Local Rules for your reference, study and feedback. Please review these rules carefully. The major changes this year include going to a pitch-count rule rather than an innings-pitched rule. These are highlighted in *red italics*.

The NSYBA Local Rules will be strictly enforced this year with no exceptions.
