With solid pitching from M.Troyke (3 innings pitched, 3 hits allowed, 1 earned run and 5 K's), N.Portokalis (2 K's), and J.Brikha (1 ip, 0 hits, 3 K's), the Lincolnwood Angels defeated the Evanston Firefighters by a score of 17-7, bringing their record to 5-0 on the season. With 2 outs and trailing 4-1 in the bottom of the 3rd, G.Crowe tied the game by crushing a 3 run homer to left center. The Firefighters roared back with 3 more runs in their half of the 4th, taking a 7-4 lead.
