He must have remembered opening day 10 days earlier when his walk-off single up the middle sent the home crowd home happy. For what followed was a play that will be emblazed in Lincolnwood folklore for decades to come: a home run over the right center field fence that was estimated at 315 feet to end the game. Thus, the game was called on account of darkness at the bottom of the fifth. So the score reverted to a 13-13 tie. These game notes include the top of the sixth, when the Skokie Indians Classics 2 scored an additional three runs.

Walks and errors were big factors in the 29 total runs scored. The Wilmette Lugnuts' pitchers gave up 9 walks, and 3 Classics baserunners reached via errors. But the Classics also successfully swung the bat when given the opportunity: we tallied 12 base hits, including a clean double by C.Benesch and a ringing triple by M.Friend. Kudos to Bill Benesch for finding a hitch in Friend's swing and correcting it just before the triple! Every Classics player reached at least once via base hits!

The Classics pitchers were quite effective, giving up only 8 base hits. B.Zarky reported after he got off the mound of having a sore arm from wrestling, which accounts for his unusually high 4 walks. N.Slaggert only issued 2 free passes in his 2 innings and C.Benesch didn't walk anyone in his 2 innings on the mound. Six Lugnuts reached via errors. These errors were mostly due to many players deliberately playing out of their normal positions purely for Summer Baseball grins.
